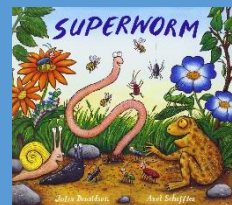
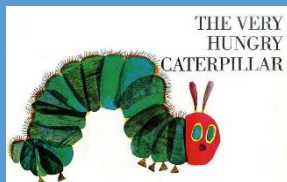
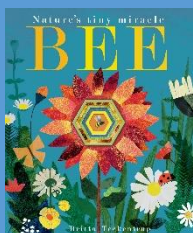
Key Maths Facts:

Subitise to 5.

Compares objects up to 10, recognising when one quantity is greater than, less than or the same.
Explores and represents patterns within 10 including evens and odds, double facts and how quantities can be distributed equally.

Please practise these facts so that your child can recall them by heart.

In English we will be creating writing inspired by these books.



Please remember to read with your child each night. Ten minutes of practice really will make a difference. To support your child's understanding of a text, you could ask them...

1. How does the character feel? How do you know?
2. Did you like the story? Which part was your favourite?
3. Can you retell me the story without opening the book?

Finally, this half term our children are thinking about how to be HAPPY Albany All Stars. We will cover this in assemblies, circle times and PSHE lessons. Please ask your child how they are HAPPY in school and at home.
